### **An inquisition taken for our Sovereign Lady the Queen**

At the Royal Courts of Justice  
In the District of Inner West London

Opened on 6 January 2004  
And, upon adjournment, continuing from 2 October 2007 to [ ] April 2008

Touching upon the death of Diana, Princess of Wales

1. Name of the deceased: Diana, Princess of Wales

2. Injury or disease causing death :

1a. Chest Injury (laceration within the left pulmonary vein and the immediately adjacent portion of the left atrium of the heart)

3. Time, place and circumstances at or in which injury was sustained ('narrative conclusion'):
