Regional, sub-regional and local gross value added

Regional GVA (NUTS1)

In 2007, London's gross value added (GVA) per head of population was 52.3 per cent above the average for the United Kingdom (UK), while that of Wales was 25.5 per cent below, calculated on a residence basis. The 2007 headline estimates show that total GVA, before allowing for inflation, has been increasing in all UK regions.

Overall UK (excluding the statistical discrepancy and Extra-Regio) GVA growth in 2007 was 6.0 per cent. The highest growth was in London (7.1 per cent), followed by Northern Ireland (6.2 per cent) and the South East (6.1 per cent). The lowest growth was in Wales (5.1 per cent), followed by the North East (5.2 per cent).

Sub-regional GVA (NUTS2)

Inner London had the largest GVA per head on a workplace basis (£52,857) for 2006, the latest year for which estimates are available, within the 37 NUTS2 areas of the United Kingdom (mainly groups of counties); Cornwall and Isles of Scilly had the lowest (£11,939). These figures compare with the UK average (excluding Extra-Regio) of £18,945.

Local GVA (NUTS3)

The 2006 estimates for the 133 NUTS3 areas (principally individual counties and unitary authorities) of the UK show Inner London - West had the largest GVA per head (£93,144) and Isle of Anglesey had the smallest (£10,560).

Regional, sub-regional and local GVA estimates

GVA estimates are available for 12 regions and countries of the UK plus Extra-Regio (off-shore GVA that cannot be assigned to any region - see background note 7), 37 sub-regions (NUTS2) and 133 local areas (NUTS3). These estimates are consistent with the National Accounts Blue Book 2008.

Regional GVA estimates (NUTS1) for 2007 are being released for the first time along with revisions for the period 1989 to 2006. These estimates update those published in December 2007.

At the more detailed level of geography (NUTS2 and NUTS3) estimates for 2006 are being released for the first time along with revisions for the period 1995 to 2005, updating estimates published in December 2007.


Regional GVA estimates (1989 to 2007)

Growth rates of total GVA

Total GVA has been increasing in all UK regions. At current prices, the regions that experienced the highest growth in total GVA between 2006 and 2007 were London (7.1 per cent), Northern Ireland (6.2 per cent) and the South East (6.1 per cent). Most regions experienced a growth rate similar to the UK average of 6.0 per cent. Growth in Wales was the lowest (5.1 per cent).

GVA per head of population

GVA per head of population for the UK as a whole, excluding Extra-Regio, was £19,956 in 2007. London had the highest GVA per head (£30,385). The South East (£22,624) and the East of England (£20,524) were also above the UK average. All other regions had a GVA per head value below the UK average. Wales (£14,877) had the lowest, followed by the North East (£15,688) and Northern Ireland (£16,170). However, GVA per head has been increasing in all regions.




Shares of GVA

London (18.9 per cent) and the South East (15.4 per cent) had the largest share of total UK GVA in 2007. The contributions of London and the South East to UK GVA have both increased since 1995, when they accounted for 16.1 per cent and 14.8 per cent respectively. Northern Ireland (2.3 per cent) and the North East (3.3 per cent) had the smallest share of UK GVA in 2007. The contribution of Northern Ireland to UK GVA remains unchanged from 1995 levels, whereas the contribution of the North East has fallen from 1995, when it accounted for 3.7 per cent of UK GVA.

GVA per head indices

London had the highest regional GVA per head of population index in 2007 (152, where UK=100). This compares with the 1995 estimate for London (135), as calculated on a residence basis. Wales had the lowest index (75), which compares with the 1995 estimate for Wales (83).

Growth rates of total GVA


Total GVA has been increasing in all UK NUTS2 and NUTS3 areas.

Within NUTS2 areas, growth in total GVA between 2005 and 2006 was highest in Highlands and Islands (6.9 per cent) and Inner London (6.8 per cent).


The NUTS2 areas with the lowest growth between 2005 and 2006 in total GVA were West Midlands and Lincolnshire, with both increasing by 3.8 per cent.

GVA per head of population

The NUTS2 areas with the highest GVA per head of population in 2006 were Inner London (£52,857), Berkshire, Buckinghamshire and Oxfordshire (£25,789) and North Eastern Scotland (£24,550). Within NUTS2, the areas with the lowest GVA per head were Cornwall and Isles of Scilly (£11,939), West Wales and the Valleys (£12,071) and Lincolnshire (£13,118).



The NUTS3 areas with the highest GVA per head in 2006 were Inner London - West (£93,144), City of Edinburgh (£30,620) and Inner London - East (£29,351). The NUTS3 areas with the lowest GVA per head in 2006 were Isle of Anglesey (£10,560), Gwent Valleys (£10,987) and Wirral (£11,199). These estimates compare with the UK average GVA per head of £18,945 in 2006.



GVA per head indices


The NUTS2 area of Inner London had the largest GVA per head index in 2006 (279). In contrast, the GVA per head index for the NUTS2 area Cornwall and the Isles of Scilly was the lowest at 63. Inner London - West had the largest GVA per head index within NUTS3 areas (492), while that of Isle of Anglesey (56) was the lowest.

Variation within NUTS regions

Within the 12 regions and countries of the United Kingdom (NUTS1), the GVA of the 37 sub-regions (NUTS2) and 133 districts and unitary authorities (NUTS3) areas can vary considerably. For example, the GVA per head of the NUTS1 region of London in 2006 was £28,530; the GVA per head for the NUTS2 areas Inner London and Outer London were £52,857 and £17,149 respectively. Meanwhile the GVA per head for NUTS3 Inner London – West and Outer London – East & North East was £93,144 and £13,382 respectively.

Over time, differences in regional economic activity can become apparent. For example in the East of England GVA per head on a workplace basis was £10,531 in 1995 and £17,890 in 2006. The component NUTS2 sub-regions of Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire, East Anglia and Essex had GVA per head values of £11,711, £10,634 and £9,229 respectively in 1995. By 2006 these had changed to Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire £20,855, East Anglia £17,259, and Essex £15,827. Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire GVA per head was 31.8 per cent greater than Essex in 2006 compared with 26.9 per cent in 1995.

Looking at the NUTS3 areas within Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire the divergence is also evident. In 1995 the three NUTS3 areas that make up Bedfordshire and Hertfordshire had similar GVA per head values: £11,274 in Luton, £10,909 in Bedfordshire CC and £12,080 in Hertfordshire. By 2006 the spread of GVA per head had changed substantially, with Luton 3.4 per cent below the NUTS2 value with £20,150, Bedfordshire 19.1 per cent below the NUTS2 value with £16,880 and Hertfordshire 7.9 per cent higher than the NUTS2 value with £22,496. Revisions

Revisions to regional GVA estimates in this release cover the period 1989 to 2006. Estimates at lower geographical level are being revised for the period 1995 to 2005 with the starting point of the NUTS2 and NUTS3 time series being 1995.

The main reasons for revisions:

In the UK National Accounts Blue Book 2008, a new method of calculating financial intermediation services indirectly measured (FISIM) was introduced. An article 'Overview of UK National Accounts and Balance of Payments: Blue Book and Pink Book 2008' by Ross Meader and Geoff Tily was released to accompany the new estimates and explains in detail the methodological changes and results: <http://www.statistics.gov.uk/cci/article.asp?ID=2055>

The revisions in the national accounts cover the GDP time series as far back as 1961. For regional accounts the changes cover the whole time series (from 1989 at NUTS1 and 1995 at NUTS2 and 3). The effect on the national data is to lower the GVA for each industry but to increase GVA (and GDP) overall. This is mirrored in the regional data, where the most significant effects are seen in the regions with the largest concentration of the financial services industries (primarily London and, to a lesser extent, Scotland and the South East). The effect on London's GVA is to increase it in each year by between 6 and 9 per cent, although this only has a limited impact on growth rates. The smallest effects are seen in the East Midlands and Wales.

PAYE data from Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs (HMRC), used in the compilation of compensation of employees estimates, were revised for 2004/05 and 2005/06 and new estimates supplied for 2006/07. In addition, HMRC supplied revised data for sole traders and partnerships for 2005/06, along with new estimates for 2006/07.

Final estimates for 2006 became available from the Annual Survey of Hours and Earnings (ASHE), Annual Business Inquiry and other data sets.

Future work plans

ONS plans to publish estimates of regional GVA for 1989 to 2008 and sub-regional and local GVA for 1995 to 2007 in December 2009. The publication of regional household income estimates for the period 1995 to 2007 is currently planned for the spring of 2009.

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Annex A: Diversity of the NUTS1 regions

Scotland, Wales, Northern Ireland and the regions of England have differing demographic characteristics, industrial structure and economic performance. The table overleaf shows some of the differences.

Scotland has the largest area, but a small population; London has by far the smallest area, but the second largest percentage of the population - over 12 per cent. At the other extreme, Northern Ireland has the smallest population: 2.9 per cent of the UK total. These large variations in the regions' populations are reflected in the size of regional GVA and incomes.

The wide variation in the size of the regions makes it difficult to compare the regions' economic performance using cash totals. Comparisons are therefore usually expressed in terms of amounts per head of the population. However, it is important to note that the growth in totals may be quite different from the growth per head in regions where the population has increased or decreased.

Furthermore, the level per head is determined both by the average amount of cash of the working population and by the proportion of dependants. Some regions will have a high proportion of children, which will tend to depress amounts per head. Ideally the age structure of the population should, therefore, be taken into account when comparing figures on a per head basis.

BACKGROUND NOTES

Basic quality information

1. Key Issues specific to this release

There are three main changes incorporated in this release compared with the previous publication:

- the introduction of a new method for recording financial intermediation services (FISIM) at UK level, so that output is allocated to the intermediate consumption of the relevant industries or, where appropriate, to final consumption of households, general government or the rest of the world
- the reinstatement of the industrial breakdowns of regional GVA which were suspended in the 2007 publication (Regional, sub-regional and local gross value added December 2007 background note 1 refers). In addition, an expanded industrial breakdown at NUTS3 level (six industries instead of three) is published today for the first time, in line with a new European Union requirement
- the transfer of North East Moray from North East Scotland to Highlands and Islands NUTS2 region to reflect its move into the Highlands and Islands Enterprise Area that took effect from 2001, requested by Highlands and Islands Enterprise Council. This change enables the new Highlands and Islands NUTS2 region to be coterminous with the Highlands and Enterprise Area as well as placing the whole of the Moray Council area in the same NUTS2 and NUTS3 region. Furthermore the three wards in this part of Scotland which are currently split between NUTS2 regions are reunited.

Relevance to users

3. The Nomenclature of Units for Territorial Statistics (NUTS) provides a single uniform breakdown for the production of regional statistics for the European Union. There are three levels of NUTS in the UK:
 - NUTS1: Government Office Regions and Wales, Scotland, Northern Ireland.
 - NUTS2: 37 areas – mainly groups of counties and unitary authorities; can be referred to as sub-regions
 - NUTS3: 133 areas – principally individual counties and unitary authorities; also known as local areas.
 - Some areas appear at more than one level, for example Northern Ireland appears at NUTS1 and NUTS2 level.
4. The NUTS1 GVA estimates presented here are on a residence basis. This means that earnings of individuals are allocated to the region in which they live. NUTS2 and NUTS3 GVA estimates are on a workplace basis and consistent with estimates of workplace-based NUTS1 GVA estimates. This complies with the European System of Economic Accounts 1995 (ESA95). It is currently assumed that the regions of London, East of England and the South East are the only regions where net commuting has a significant impact on regional GVA.
5. Estimates are at current basic prices and do not allow for changes in prices over time (inflation) or differences in regional price levels (purchasing power).
6. The headline regional GVA series have been calculated using a five year moving average technique. These adjusted series remove some year to year volatility in the unadjusted series. The unadjusted series are also provided for information on the National Statistics website (<http://www.statistics.gov.uk/statbase/Product.asp?vlnk=14650>).
7. The contribution to GVA of UK embassies abroad and UK forces stationed overseas is included in Extra-Regio, along with the elements relating to activities taking place on the continental shelf. As these cannot be assigned to specific regions they are assigned as "Extra-Regio GVA". The statistical discrepancy is the difference between the sum of the national income components and the definitive national estimate of GVA.

Common pitfalls in interpreting series

8. Very few statistical revisions arise as a result of 'errors' in the popular sense of the word. All estimates, by definition, are subject to statistical 'error' but, in this context, the word refers to the uncertainty in any process or calculation that uses sampling, estimation or modelling. Most revisions reflect either the adoption of new statistical techniques or the incorporation of new information which allows the statistical error of previous estimates to be reduced. Only rarely are there avoidable 'errors' such as human or system 'errors' and such mistakes are made clear when they are discovered and corrected.

Accuracy

9. Figures for the latest year are provisional and the whole series are subject to revisions in light of revised National Accounts Blue Book data in future years.

Reliability

10. As with the national accounts, regional, sub-regional and local GVA estimates are calculated as reliably as possible. There is no easy way to measure the reliability of the estimates but ONS carries out consistency checks on data inputs, applies methods consistently and makes use of local knowledge for England, Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. The estimates are partly based on sample surveys and the quality of the results therefore varies according to sample size. This means that the results for smaller regions are subject to a greater degree of uncertainty than those for larger regions. Revisions to the GVA estimates for the latest previously published year (2006) are shown overleaf.
