6. terminating the team ministry established for the benefice of Rodbourne Cheney, and creating

the new benefices and parishes of St John, Haydon Wick, and of St Andrew, North Swindon, diocese of Bristol

7. uniting the benefices of Brampton and Farlam and Castle Corrock with Cumrew, of Hayton with Cumwhitton and of Irthington, Crosby-on-Eden and Scaleby, diocese of Carlisle;

8. uniting the benefices of West Bergholt and of Great Horkesley, diocese of Chelmsford;

9. uniting the parishes of Rye and of Rye Harbour, diocese of Chichester;

10. terminating the plurality established for the benefices of Wiggenhall St Germans with St Mary and of Wiggenhall St Mary Magdalen and for the benefices of Terrington St John, of Tilney All Saints and of Tilney St Lawrence, and uniting all those benefices, diocese of Ely.

11. amending the patronage arrangements in the scheme creating the new benefice of Soham and Wicken confirmed by Her Majesty in Council on 11 December 2001;

12. terminating the team ministry established for the benefice of Heavitree with St Paul, Exeter, uniting that benefice with the benefice of St Mary Steps, Exeter, and establishing a team ministry for the new benefice, diocese of Exeter;

13. creating the new benefice of Mickleton, Willersey, Saintbury, Weston-sub-Edge and Aston-sub-Edge, dissolving the benefice of

Quinton with Marston Sicca, creating the new benefices of Quinton and of Marston Sicca and uniting the latter with the benefice of Pebworth with Dorsington and Honeybourne and the former with the benefice of Welford with Weston, diocese of Gloucester;

14. appropriating part of the churchyard of St Mary the Virgin, Cleobury Mortimer, to use for community purposes, diocese of Hereford;

15. creating the new parish of Muxton St John the Evangelist, diocese of Lichfield;

16. declaring redundant the church of St John the Divine, Gainsborough, diocese of Lincoln;

17. declaring redundant the church of St Paul, Old Ford, diocese of London;

18. terminating the team ministry established for the benefice of Whitworth, Manchester, dissolving that benefice, creating an extra-parochial place, and altering the areas of a number of parishes, diocese of Manchester;

19. uniting the benefices of Christ with All Saints, Heaton Norris, of Heaton Mersey, of Norris Bank and of St Paul, Heaton Moor, diocese of Manchester;

20. uniting the parishes of Pangbourne, of Tidmarsh and of Sulham, diocese of Oxford;

21. uniting the benefices of Blidworth and of St Simon and St Jude, Rainworth, diocese of Southwell;
