---


I, **John Fahy**, will say as follows:-

1. I make this statement further to my first statement dated 6 October 2006.
2. I have now been provided with a record of an interview I attended at my offices with two police officers on 29 October 1999. A true copy of the record of the interview is attached at **RNI 402.561-562**. Following this interview I met with two police officers on 16 February 2000. However I was not able to assist further. A true copy of the record of these discussions is attached at **RNI 402.581**.
3. The interview concerned an article which appeared in the Irish Times on 27 May 1987. A copy of this article is attached at **RNI 401.002**. The article concerns harassment of lawyers by the RUC who are acting on behalf of clients detained and interrogated in Derry, Armagh and Castlereagh. I am named as one of 14 solicitors who made a statement in relation to that harassment.
4. Subsequent to this interview, I received a letter from the police dated 14 June 2000 requesting that my details be passed to Param Kumaraswamy, the UN Special Rapporteur.


