RE: COMPLAINT AGAINST THE POLICE BY SHANE McCrORY  
ALLEGED INCIDENT AT LURGAN ON 15 DECEMBER 1997

I refer to your letter of 6 April 1998 addressed to Chief Inspector P146 RUC Gough.

The complaint made by you has been referred to the Chief Constable pursuant to the provisions of Article 5 of the Police (NI) Order 1987, and I have been instructed to investigate the complaint and furnish a report without delay.

In order that the investigation may be as complete as possible I wish to meet you and Mr McCrory solely to discuss the complaint. Such meetings are normal practice in these investigations and any failure to co-operate with the Investigating Officer may frustrate the completion of such investigations.

The Independent Commission for Police Complaints is supervising the investigation and the supervisory member may be present.

Please arrange to be at Lisburn RUC Station at 2.00 pm on Friday, 29 May 1998 together with Mr McCrory. If the time does not suit please telephone me at the above number so that an alternative can be arranged. If you consider Lisburn RUC Station to be unsuitable or inconvenient for whatever reason you may nominate any RUC Station which you deem to be appropriate. Alternatively, the Independent Commission for Police Complaints for Northern Ireland have agreed that the interview could take place in its offices.

On arrival please show this letter to the Duty Officer and ask to speak to Chief Inspector [REDACTED] from Complaints and Discipline Department.

If you do not agree to such a meeting, please provide me with details of witnesses and other relevant evidence which you would wish to be considered in support of this complaint.

Confirmation or otherwise of this appointment should be made by completing the attached pro forma and returning it in the prepaid envelope provided. Please note that if I do not receive a reply by 26 May 1998 I shall assume that you do not intend keeping the appointment and I shall not attend.
