**SUBJECT: ROSEMARY NELSON - ALLEGED DEATH THREATS BY RUC**

1. I refer to my telephone conversation with your deputy, Chief Inspector McMullan, yesterday. As agreed I forward herewith copy letters to enable you to consider what action, if any, is required regarding the security or safety of Ms Nelson. It would seem that the murder of Pat Finucane, Solicitor, has prompted others to specifically raise the security aspect.
2. Chief Inspector Gamble, Complaints & Discipline, Gough, is investigating the complaint which has been made on behalf of Ms Nelson. ICPC are supervising the investigation. To date Ms Nelson has ignored correspondence from Chief Inspector Gamble seeking an interview. We in 'G' Department presently have no information over and above that contained in the letters. The Investigating Officer has again written to Ms R Nelson seeking an interview on 13 June 1997. The Investigating Officer is available to provide any information to enable Special Branch or others to assess the threat.
