

25. I note that I said in this statement that the Liaison Officer was worried about petrol bombs. I think that he said that to the Aircraft Commander and I would have picked it up on the radio. It was not the done thing to quiz the Liaison Officer about what was going on in the air but you did try to pick up as much information as you could whilst you were flying. I think he was wondering whether or not he had found out where they were making the petrol bombs.
26. I note this statement indicates that we did not refuel at Aldergrove. I believe that this is accurate in preference to my current recollection as the statement was taken at the time.
27. The next statement I gave is dated 17 April 2000. This is attached at **RNI 833.169-171**. This statement contains a lot of references to the time at which various events occurred. I am sure these times are accurate as I would have looked them up prior to giving the statement. The statement also refers to a 'signals log'. I think this is something that we were given when we were provided with our kit. It might have been that Int Cell people had something to do with the information contained in that log but I am not sure. I am also not sure what happened to it afterwards. I imagine that the Aircraft Commander had to brief the Flight Commander (who was next up in the line of command) as to what had happened and that this might have been put in the signals log.
28. I have been asked to comment on whether or not I made a landing other than those detailed in my statement in any of the fields around Lurgan. I did not make any landings on this or any other occasion. I have never been asked to do so and I would not have been happy to do so as a Gazelle would have been very vulnerable on the ground as it cannot lift off very quickly.

29. I was not aware of Rosemary Nelson at all prior to her death. I have been asked whether I wondered after her murder whether the scenes I saw in the Kilwilkie Estate that night had been to draw attention from what was going on elsewhere. That would be pure speculation on
