PRIVATE RECORD OF MEETING

1. Issue of whether letter was a complaint - no -
2. Were my concerns pertaining to all I's (inc ACC Stewart) - yes -
3. He considered investigation had not been concluded because of the issues arising + that it was not irreparably damaged. Stated he was formally withdrawing 'completion' of investigation.
1. Proposal that an external officer be brought in to take 'further investigative steps' - at the highest level, under my supervision to deal with
 - (i) allegations of the complaints
 - (ii) whether there have been attempts to obstruct the investigation.
2. He queried that relationship between supervision / investigation - Said matters should have been brought to his attention. That ACC [REDACTED] had never received a copy of the letter dated 20th March '98 from ICP. CC proceeded to read aloud an internal report submitted by C.I. P146 to Supt.
