Please find attached Fax message received from Lawyers Alliance for Justice in Ireland dated 30 June 1997. This should be read in conjunction with previous correspondence of this subject.

Although the Fax appears to introduce new complaints which are linked to the ongoing investigation, it remains the case that the allegations in their present form appear to be based on hearsay and inuendo.

Mrs Nelson has failed to attend for 2 recently agreed interviews and I have now sent her a Regulation 17 letter with a reply due by 24 July 1997.

In the meantime I have appraised Sub-Divisional Commander Lurgan of the ongoing correspondence for whatever action he considers necessary vis a vis Mrs Nelson's ongoing security.
