Witness Statement of Geralyn McNally

I, **Geralyn McNally**, will say as follows:-

1. I graduated from Queen's University, Belfast, in 1992, with an LLB degree in law and went on to University College, Dublin and obtained an LLM in European law in 1993. I was admitted to the Northern Ireland Bar in September 1994, and practised as a barrister until 2002. I have held membership of the King's Inn Bar of Ireland, from 1998 and associate membership of the Bar Library in Belfast since 2002.
2. I held two public appointments; one with the Independent Commission for Police Complaints ("ICPC") from 1997-2000, and a second with the Law Reform Advisory Committee for Northern Ireland between 2000 and 2004. I have also worked as a part time lecturer in The University of Ulster at Coleraine from 1994 until 1996, Institute of Professional Legal Studies from 1997 onwards, and also at the Belfast Institute of Further and Higher Education between 1997 and 2000. Recently, I have been appointed to the part time Lecturers' Panel, of the East Down Institute of Further and Higher Education. I have
