

## RE: MEETING WEDNESDAY 19 AUGUST 1998

Discussion took place of three related but separate issues: and in consultation with 'Terms of Reference' as attached - 13 August 1998 :-

1. Investigation of two new complaints: C1553/98 9  
 C1554/98 1

On behalf of R. Nelson and James Donnelly regarding alleged threats made at Castlereagh Holding Centre during July 1998.

It was agreed that Tuesday 1 September 1998 be allocated for interviews of both complainants.

[Pursuant to telephone conversation with Commander Mulvihill on Monday 24 August 1998 (3-3.15 pm) a time of 11.00 am for arranged interviews was agreed.

Commander Mulvihill will attend ICPC offices with DCI [REDACTED] and D/Sgt Tim Nelligan, Complaints Investigation Bureau on this date].

It was also agreed that correspondence be forwarded by the I.O. and ICPC to both complainants and that the I.O. in addition make contact with Sir Louis Blom-Cooper Q.C., Independent Commissioner for Holding Centres (Tel: [REDACTED] as an interested party.

2. Re-investigation/further investigation into

4. (a) Complaints by Rosemary Nelson and Colin Duffy [attached report submitted by ACC Stewart].

- : It was clarified by Supervising Member that both complainants had been interviewed and provided statements but should be re-interviewed and further that although two witnesses, namely C199 and C204 had provided statements through R. Nelson, neither had appeared for interview. They likewise needed to be interviewed. I referred Commander Mulvihill to various custody records/interview notes already on file in respect of the two witnesses and in respect of Colin Duffy.
- : Provisionally the 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> of September have been set aside for these interviews (times to be firmed up), with ICPC as proposed venue.
- : All non-police interviews (under re-investigation of (a) and (b) below) are to be observed by Edmund Lynch per his specific request to do so. He has indicated by telephone that he plans to be in the jurisdiction mid-September. In any event he has indicated two weeks advance notice of proposed interviews is sufficient. The I.O. and ICPC will write to him personally.
