A stage has now been reached in relation to the investigation of the above complaints where I have drawn a number of serious concerns to the attention of both the Secretary of State and the Chief Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary. These relate to the investigation to date and as a result it has been decided that further investigative steps be undertaken by Commander N Mulvihill, Specialist Operations Department, Metropolitan Police at my direction and under my immediate supervision.

Commission has a statutory and ethical obligation to seek to ensure that all complaints are thoroughly and satisfactorily investigated. To this end I would urge your continued co-operation with these investigations, as your contribution is central to the investigation's ultimate outcome.
