**COMMANDER MULVIHILL'S REPORT ON COMPLAINTS MADE BY THE LATE ROSEMARY NELSON**

**Issue:** The ICPC's statement on Commander Mulvihill's investigation into complaints made by and on behalf of Mrs Nelson was issued today.

**Timescale:** Immediate.

**Recommendation:** That the Secretary of State notes the current position.

**Background**

Mr Rogers' submission of 16 March advised that, at the request of the late Rosemary Nelson's family, the ICPC had agreed not to issue their statutory statement on the conduct of the investigation into various complaints made by and on behalf of Mrs Nelson, until today.

**Statement**

2. The statement has now been issued to the Nelson family and other complainants and we have received a copy (see attached). While there is no intention on the ICPC's part to make the statement public, it seems likely that the statement will be made available to the media by the complainants.
3. In addition to the investigation into the Nelson complaints, Commander Mulvihill also reviewed the original investigation in light of the ICPC concerns. We
