

RESTRICTED - POLICY**LINES TO TAKE****MULVIHILL INVESTIGATION**

- I understand that the ICPC have issued their statement on the conduct of this investigation to the complainants and the Chief Constable. The statement was delayed at the request of the Nelson family.
- The file will go from the Chief Constable to the Director of Public Prosecutions.
- **[ICPC expressed "serious concern"]** The ICPC referred to having serious concern about the RUC investigation. These concerns were first expressed in June and immediately led to the Chief Constable appointing, with the ICPC's approval and under ICPC supervision, Commander Mulvihill to carry out an investigation.
- Reassured that the ICPC have expressed their satisfaction with his investigation.
- Not possible to comment further on the investigation into the case, which will now be considered by the DPP.
- **[Waste of time. DPP not going to press charges]** Cannot comment on what action the Director of Public Prosecutions might take. The papers will now be sent to DPP and we await his decision.
- **(Have you seen the report ?)** Yes. I am pleased to see that the ICPC were satisfied with Commander Mulvihill's investigation.
