While the Commission is satisfied that the investigation has now been properly carried out, its role in the matter does not end here.~~


A copy of the investigation report has been sent to the Assistant Chief Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary who may, depending upon whether or not he determines that it indicates that a criminal offence may have been committed by a member of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, forward a copy to the Director of Public Prosecutions.

Whether or not criminal charges are preferred against any RUC officer there is a second stage at which the Independent Commission for Police Complaints will examine the details of the case again. At this point another Member who has not previously been concerned with the investigation will assess the papers and a decision will be made on whether or not to accept the Assistant Chief Constable's findings on the disciplinary aspects.

You will be advised in due course of the outcome of the disciplinary aspects of your complaint.

With reference to the Commission's letter of 4 March 1999, I would be grateful if you would advise if you will be able to attend the Commission's offices on 30 March 1999.
