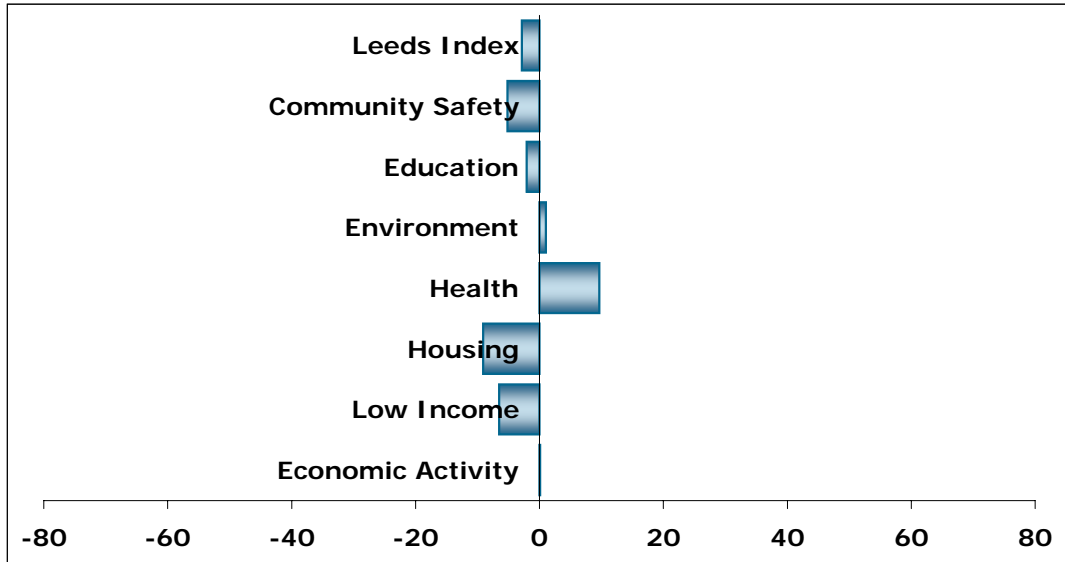

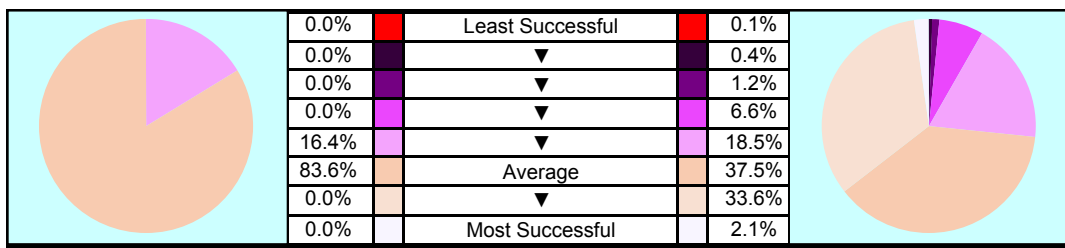


The area is located in the Inner South. It is bounded by Cross Flatts Park and industrial estates to the east, Middleton woods and Beeston Golf Course to the south before cutting up through Beeston to Beeston Road.

The age breakdown shows a slightly higher than average proportion of children and young people. At 10% the BME population broadly reflects the city average.

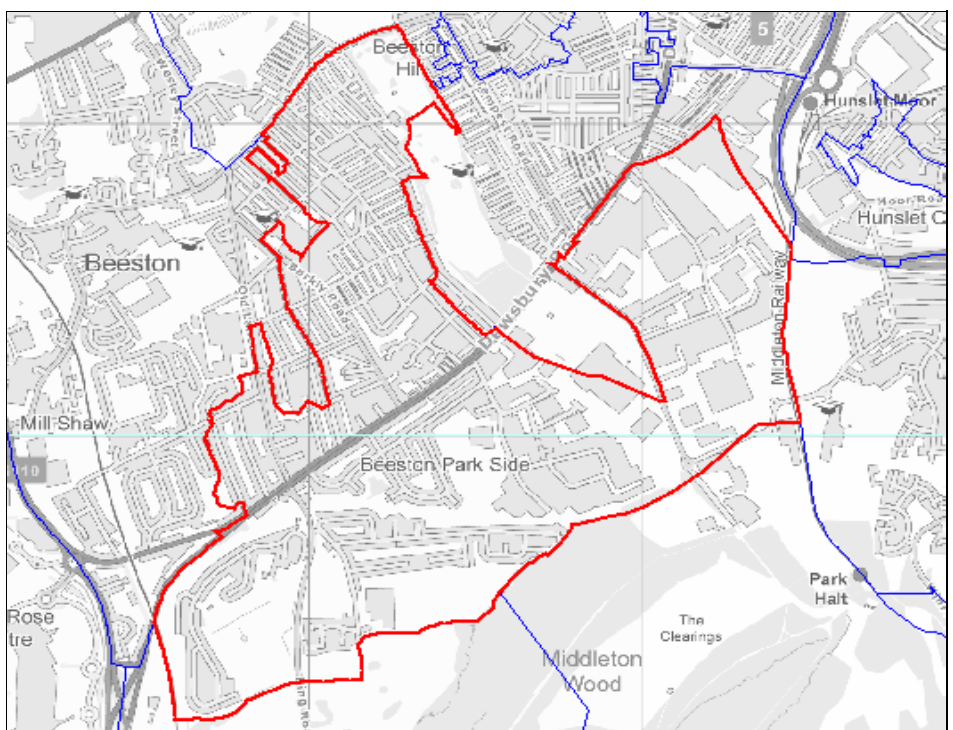
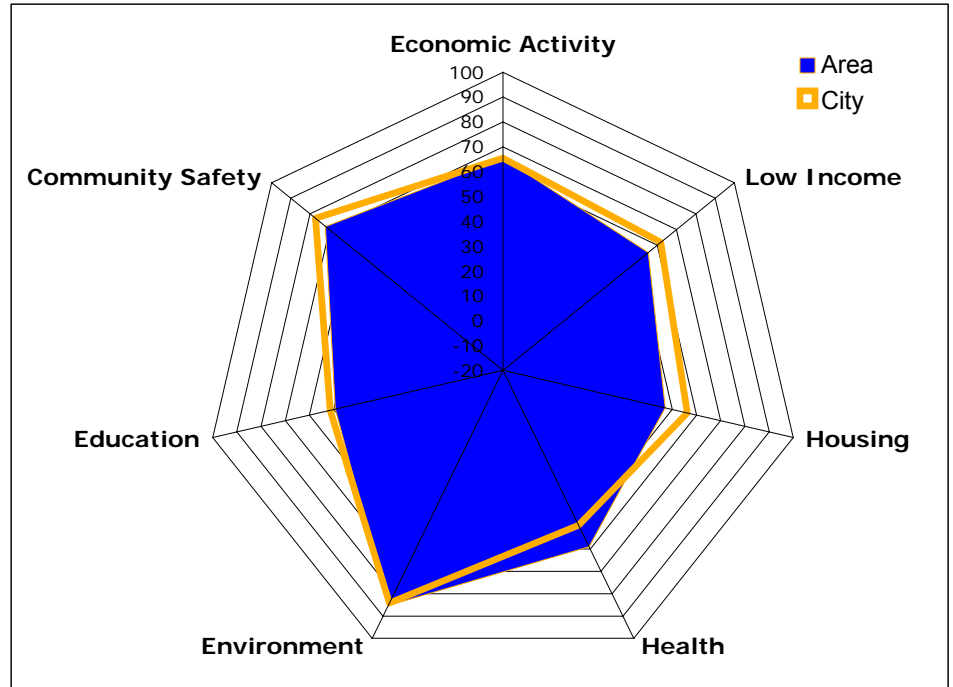
80% of households are in owner occupation. Semi-detached housing accounts for 44% of the stock and terraced housing for a further 42%. 39% of properties are classified in Council Tax band A and 42% in Band B.

Key services located in the area: Cocburn College of Arts; South Leeds City Learning Centre; St Anthony's Catholic Primary School; and 2 health centres. Parkside and Westland Road industrial estates are a significant part of the MSOA area.
