



SUMMARY OF ROBERTS PARK SPECIAL NEIGHBOURHOOD FORUM – 19th JULY 2010

Summary of Key Issues

The Chair welcomed everyone to the Special Forum and made introductions. Residents were advised of the Report Back Sheet and the 'Have you say' form.

Students from Titus Salt School provided a PowerPoint presentation on the history of Roberts Park and the details of the Park before and after the works. The Students informed the attendees of the Parks Charter, advising of the old and new rules. A short video produced by the Students on Roberts Park was shown.

The Assistant Manager, Parks & Landscapes gave an update on the renovations and issues affecting maintenance of the Park. He reported that on a good day the park is populated by 3,000 people. Information on events delivered by Partner organisations, including the bandstand concerts was provided.

Residents, Titus Salt students and representatives of local voluntary groups worked together in small groups to identify issues to be included in the Charter to keep Roberts Park clean and safe.
