- human papillomavirus (HPV)
- pandemic influenza A(H1N1) 2009 (swine flu).

p.76 Time and age limits

Replace with second paragraph with:

Claimants must have been immunised before their eighteenth birthday, unless the immunisation was against polio, rubella, meningitis C, human papillomavirus or pandemic influenza A(H1N1) 2009 for which there is no upper age limit. In addition, individuals of any age are eligible if immunised against any of the other listed diseases during an outbreak within the UK or the Isle of Man.
