

2c.2	In consultation with the appropriate Line Controllers and in strict compliance with Section E of the <i>Reference Manual</i> , control the charge / discharge of traction current by using the substation track feeder circuit breakers in LUL's Power Control Room.
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4c.4.2.19 GROUP STATION MANAGERS

2.4.2.1	Are responsible for managing the local interface with other train and station operating companies.
3.7.1	Are responsible for a designated group of stations, at which they: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • assess and control the risks associated with the operation of the stations • ensure that operations are carried out in accordance with standards • carry out safety surveys every three months • carry out evacuation exercises every six months • sign storage licenses; and • participate in station services development projects that improve the safety of station operations.
11.9	Are responsible for managing performance of operational employees. For safety critical employees this includes the following extra responsibilities: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • establishing and maintaining a register of all posts within their area of responsibility that are safety critical • issuing and updating licences • monitoring hours worked; and • ensuring that safety critical training development requirements are kept up to date and competence assessment is carried out on a continuing basis.
13.4	Are responsible for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • making decisions based on operational risks and the ability to manage the site around the works safely whilst the works is in progress; and • withdrawing access if, in the opinion, operational safety is or may be compromised.
17.3	Are responsible for producing, reviewing and maintaining local emergency plans in support of the Line and LUL Network Plan.
18.3.4	Are responsible for ensuring that effective communications take place at a local level Communication with the London Fire and Emergency Planning Authority (LFEPA) and the British Transport Police (BTP).

4c.4.2.20 PERFORMANCE MANAGER (STATIONS) [Note: For the East London and Waterloo & City lines, there is one post only for both lines covering stations and trains.]

General	The Performance Managers (Stations) report to a Line Manager and are accountable for delivering the day to day operations in their designated area. They also play a major role in the strategic development of the stations business improvements with regard to operational reliability, safety, customer service and commercial performance.
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
