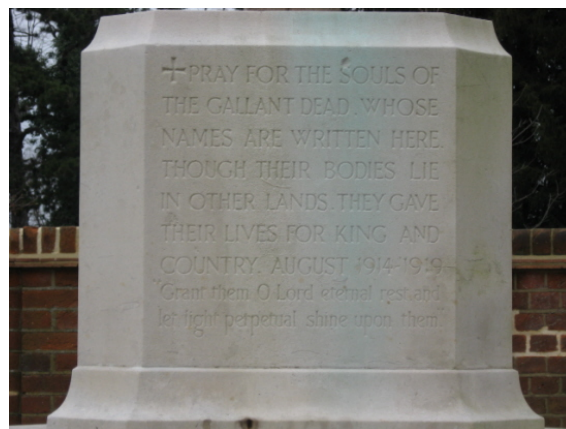

Description Wooden calvary on raised stone plinth with brick surrounding walls and carved inscriptions: PRAY FOR THE SOULS OF/ THE GALLANT DEAD, WHOSE/ NAMES ARE WRITTEN HERE/ THOUGH THEIR BODIES LIE/ IN OTHER LANDS. THEY GAVE/ THEIR LIVES FOR KING AND/ COUNTRY. 1914-1919/ GRANT THEM O LORD ETERNAL REST AND/ LET LIGHT PERPETUAL SHINE UPON THEM./ (NAMES)/ R.I.P./ PRAY ALSO FOR THOSE WHO FELL/ (NAMES)/ THE GREAT WAR 1939-1945/ (NAMES)
