THE ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT REGULATIONS (SI 2004 1633)

The Environment Agency gives notice that the Eastern Yar Flood and Erosion Management Strategy was adopted on the 22/12/10. It is available for inspection alongside its Environmental Report and a Statement of Environmental Particulars (in line with Regulation 16(4)) at the locations set out below.

The Eastern Yar Flood and Erosion Risk Management Strategy gives an overview of the risks of flooding and erosion, and identifies the best way of managing them to protect local communities and the natural environment over the next 100 years in the Eastern Yar catchment (along the Eastern Yar River and around Bembridge Harbour).
