PART A

Changes effected by Order of the Secretary of State under the Local Government and Rating Act 1997

1. THERE ARE 9 ORDERS GIVING EFFECT TO RECOMMENDATIONS RESULTING FROM THE DISTRICT REVIEWS MADE BY THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 9 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND RATING ACT 1997.

2. THERE IS 1 ORDER GIVING EFFECT TO RECOMMENDATIONS RESULTING FROM A PETITION MADE TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE UNDER SECTION 11 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND RATING ACT 1997.

1. Orders giving effect to recommendations resulting from district reviews made to the Secretary of State under section 9 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997.

**indicates that the local authority has been directed by the Secretary of State to establish a parish council.*

THE BASINGSTOKE AND DEANE (PARISHES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2004 – S.I. 2004 NO. 3194

This Order made an amendment to the Basingstoke and Deane (Parish) Order 2004. The Order substitutes the map referred to in the principle Order. The substitution was made to correct the boundary between the parishes of Rooksdown and Sherborne St John which was shown incorrectly. The Order was made on the 2 December 2004 and came into effect on the same day.

THE EAST LINDSEY (PARISHES) ORDER 2005 – S.I. 2005 NO. 338

*This Order amalgamated the parishes of Frithville and Westville to constitute a new parish of Frithville and Westville. The Order directed the East Lindsey District Council to establish a parish council for the new parish. The Order was made on 14 February 2005 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

THE FYLDE (PARISH) ORDER 2004 – S.I. 2004 NO. 2047

*This Order created a new parish of Saint Anne's on the Sea. The Order directed the Fylde Borough Council to establish a parish council for the new parish. The Order was made on 29 July 2004 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

THE MELTON (PARISHES) ORDER 2004 – S.I. 2004 NO. 2587

*This Order abolishes the parish of Frisby and Kirkby, and transfers the area between two new parishes called Frisby on the Wreake and Kirby Bellars. The Order directed the Melton Borough Council to establish parish councils for the new parishes. The Order was made on 24 September 2004 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

THE MELTON (PARISHES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2005 – S.I. 2005 NO 707

This Order amends article 1(1) of the Melton (Parishes) Order 2004 by deleting the word "Coastal". This Order was made on 14 March 2005 and came into effect on the same day.

THE SHREWSBURY AND ATCHAM (PARISHES) ORDER 2005 – S.I. 2005 NO. 376

This Order abolished the parish of Wollaston and made alterations to the boundaries of the parishes of Alberbury with Cardeston and Westbury. The Order was made on 22 February 2005 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

THE STAFFORD (PARISHES) ORDER 2004 – S.I. 2004 NO. 3399

*This Order created a new parish of Doxey and directed the Stafford Borough Council to establish a parish council for the new parish. The Order was made on 21 December 2004 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

THE SUFFOLK COASTAL (PARISHES) ORDER 2004 – S.I. 2004 NO. 2586

This Order transferred areas between the parishes of Purdis Farm and Foxhall. The Order was made on 24 September 2004 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

THE TEST VALLEY (PARISHES) ORDER 2005 – S.I. 2005 NO. 1405

This Order transferred areas between the parishes of Ampfield, Appleshaw, Braishfield, Fyfield, Goodworth Clatford, Kings Somborne, Little Somborne, Lockerley, Michelmersh and Timsbury, Romsey, Romsey Extra, Sherfield English, Upper Clatford and Wellow. The Order was made on the 31 March 2005 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

2. Orders giving effect to recommendations resulting from petitions made to the Secretary of State under section 11 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997.

**indicates that the local authority has been directed by the Secretary of State to establish a parish council.*

THE NORTH HERTFORDSHIRE (PARISH) ORDER 2004 – S.I. 2004 NO. 3195

*This Order created a new parish called Letchworth Garden City. The Order directed the North Hertfordshire District Council to establish a parish council for the new parish. The Order was made on 2 December 2004 and came into effect on 1 April 2005.

2. Order conferring parish council powers on parish meetings under section 109 of the Local Government Act 1972

HATFORD PARISH MEETING ORDER 2004 (THE VALE OF WHITE HORSE DISTRICT COUNCIL)

Allows the parish meeting of Hatford to exercise the powers of a parish council. The Order came into effect on 8 November 2004.

PARISH OF STOKE RIVERS ORDER 2004 (NORTH DEVON DISTRICT COUNCIL)

Allows the parish meeting of Stoke Rivers to exercise the powers of a parish council. The Order came into effect on 7 December 2004.

THE CHERWELL DISTRICT COUNCIL (PARISH OF HAMPTON GAY AND POYLE) PARISH COUNCIL FUNCTIONS ORDER 2004

Allows the parish meeting of Hampton Gay and Poyle to exercise the powers of a parish council. The Order came into effect on 15 September 2004.

3. Orders providing for the creation of a parish council under section 16 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997

THE MAWLSEY PARISH COUNCIL ORDER 2004 (KETTERING BOROUGH COUNCIL)

Established a parish council for the parish of Mawsley. This Order was made on 2 April 2004 and came into effect on the same day.

THE DISTRICT OF SHEPWAY (PARISH COUNCIL OF FOLKESTONE) (ESTABLISHMENT) ORDER 2004 (SHEPWAY DISTRICT COUNCIL)

Established a parish council for the parish of Folkestone. This Order was made on 30 April and came into effect on 14 May 2004.

THE DISTRICT OF SHEPWAY (PARISH COUNCIL OF SANDGATE) (ESTABLISHMENT) ORDER 2004 (SHEPWAY DISTRICT COUNCIL)

Established a parish council for the parish of Sandgate. This Order was made on 30 April 2004 and came into effect on 14 May 2004.

4. Orders amending electoral arrangements under section 17 of the Local Government and Rating Act 1997

THE BALDERSTON (ENLARGEMENT OF PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2004 (RIBBLE VALLEY BOROUGH COUNCIL)

Increased the number of councillors from six to seven. This Order was made on 19 October 2004 and came into effect on 2 December 2004.

REVIEWING THE ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR BOARHUNT PARISH ORDER 2004 (WINCHESTER CITY COUNCIL)

Increased the number of councillors from five to six. This Order was made of 14 April 2004 and came into effect the day after that which it was made.

**CHELMSLEY WOOD TOWN COUNCIL (REDUCTION OF COUNCILLORS)
ORDER 2005 (SOLIHULL METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL)**

Reduces the number of councillors from twenty to fifteen. This Order was made on 18 February 2005 and shall come into effect on 1 January 2007.

**HAMSEY PARISH COUNCIL (COUNCILLORS) ORDER 2004 (LEWES DISTRICT
COUNCIL)**

Increased the number of councillors from six to seven. This Order was made on the 13 August 2004 and shall come into effect on 15 October 2006.

**PARISH OF HIGH HALSTOW (COUNCILLORS) ORDER 2004 (MEDWAY
BOROUGH COUNCIL)**

Increased the number of councillors from seven to nine. This Order was made on 16 April 2004 and came into effect on 14 June 2004.

THE CITY OF LEEDS (SCARCROFT PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2004

Increased the number of parish councillors from five to seven. This Order was made on 26 October 2004 and came into effect on the same day.

THE MENDIP DISTRICT (DOULTING PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2005

Increased the number of parish councillors from five to six. This Order was made on 20 January 2005 and came into effect on the same day.

**THE MENDIP DISTRICT (STREET PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2005 (MENDIP
DISTRICT COUNCIL)**

Increased the number of parish councillors from twelve to sixteen. This Order was made on 4 March 2005 and shall come into operation on the day of elections for Parish Councillors in 2007.

**THE PARISH OF NETTLESTONE AND SEAVIEW (WARDS) ORDER 2004 (ISLE
OF WIGHT COUNCIL)**

Establishes ten parish councillors for the parish of Nettlestone and Seaview. This Order was made on 10 December 2004 and came into operation on 5 May 2005.

5. Orders appointing members to a parish council under section 91 of the Local Government Act 1972

BRADFORD CITY COUNCIL (SANDY LANE PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2004

This Order was made on 20 September 2004 and made temporary appointments to Sandy Lane Parish Council.

DONCASTER BOROUGH COUNCIL (BLAXTON PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2004

This Order was made on 19 October 2004 and made temporary appointments to the Blaxton Parish Council.

KETTERING BOROUGH COUNCIL (PARISH OF MAWSLEY (APPOINTMENT OF TEMPORARY COUNCILLORS)) ORDER 2004

This Order was made of 11 June 2004 and made temporary appointments to the Mawsley Parish Council.

NORTH NORFOLK DISTRICT COUNCIL (ROUGHTON PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2004

This Order was made on the 2 November 2004 and made temporary appointments to Roughton Parish Council.

RUGBY BOROUGH COUNCIL (PARISH OF ANSTY (COUNCILLORS)) ORDER 2004

This Order was made on 10 June 2004 and made temporary appointments to the Ansty Parish Council.

SOUTH LAKELAND DISTRICT COUNCIL (HUTTON ROOF PARISH COUNCIL) ORDER 2004

This Order was made on 15 December 2004 and made temporary appointments to the Hutton Roof Parish Council.

6. Orders under section 11 of the Local Government Act 1972 – Grouping Orders

This Order grouped under a Common Parish Council the parishes of Hugill, Nether Staveley and Over Staveley. The group name is “The Staveley with Ings Group” and the Common Parish Council is named “The Parish Council of Staveley with Ings”. The Order was made on 29 April 2004.

WEST DORSET DISTRICT COUNCIL (PIDDLER VALLEY GROUPED PARISH COUNCIL (ADDITIONAL PARISH COUNCILLOR – PARISH OF PIDDLERENTHIDE) ORDER 2004
