General Sale List (GSL) Medicines

A product is GSL if it is composed solely of one or more of the following:

- ◆ A substance listed in column 1 of the following table and complying with the conditions (if any) described for that substance in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5 of the table
- ◆ An aqueous or alcoholic extract, spirit, syrup or liquid suspension derived from a substance listed in column 1
- ◆ An excipient

and it is not promoted, recommended or marketed:

- ◆ For use as an anthelmintic
- ◆ For parenteral administration
- ◆ For use as an eye ointment
- ◆ For use as an enema
- ◆ For use wholly or mainly for irrigation of wounds or of the bladder, vagina or rectum
- ◆ For administration wholly or mainly to children being a preparation of aloxiprin or aspirin

If a substance is listed in column 1 of the table but does not comply with all the conditions (if any) in columns 2, 3, 4 and 5, then a product containing it will be a Pharmacy (P) medicine. If a substance is neither on the GSL list nor on the POM list, then it is likely to be a P substance.

For certain substances listed in column 1 of the table, there is a cross-reference to List C (consolidated list of substances which are present in authorised products that have been reclassified since 1/4/02). In these circumstances the user should look in List C for details of the conditions for GSL supply of that substance.
