The retirement has been accepted by the Standardisation Committee for Care Information (SCCI), the successor to ISB.

Date of retirement:	09 September 2015
Description	<p>This central return is used to provide the Department of Health with information about the number of uses made of the Mental Health Act 1983 legislation (except for guardianship cases under sections 7 and 37), as amended by the Mental Health Act 2007, and other legislation.</p> <p>Following the introduction of SCCI011 Mental Health Services Data Set (MHSDS) the need for KP90 has lessened as the majority of data items are now included within that data set. However for the small number of organisations who can't yet flow MHSDS, they will still need to submit the KP90 central return. On that basis, along with a number of changes that have not yet been incorporated into the ISB approved standard, the Standardisation Committee for Care Information (SCCI) has accepted both the withdrawal of the information standard and the corresponding update of the NHS Data Model and Dictionary.</p> <p>This ISN formally withdraws the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ISB 0154 KP90: Informal Patients and Patients Detained under the Mental Health Act: The Number of Uses of the Act • DSCN 26/2008: KP90 – Admissions, Changes in Status and Detentions under the Mental Health Act: Updates for the Mental Health Act 2007
